

Note: Spanish is not mandatory for an internship since English can be used; however, speaking Spanish will improve your chances to get a spot in a company.

- 1) Being at least in your 3rd year of bachelor program
- 2) Official transcript with a grade point average of 2.5 in the USA scale (80 in the Mexican system).
- 3) Two letters of recommendation from a professor or staff member of the home university
- 4) Recent resumé in English or Spanish depending on the language in which you want to perform your internship.
- 5) Letter of intention explaining the reasons why you would like to have an internship in Mexico.
- 6) Interviews (only when needed)







• Fill out general **Application for Admission** to Tecnológico de Monterrey available at **https://goo.gl/QINFXc**. Have a digital copy of your passport ready since you will be prompted to submit a copy.







· Ask your Study Abroad Advisor at your home university to nominate you as an EXCHANGE STUDENT on the **Nomination Format** available at https://goo.gl/1fWIW7







- · Send complete internship requirements to Mrs. Maria Elena Arévalo, Academic Director for International Students (marevalo@itesm.mx).
- Once students complete this procedure, Tecnológico de Monterrey will evaluate the student's profile to determine if the applicant is apt to participate in the program. This process may take a couple of weeks and may require constant communication between the Academic Director and the student. If the student is accepted, he/she will receive a confirmation of acceptance*.

Internship placement

· Once the student is accepted as an internship candidate, the placement process will begin. Students may receive information about different projects that fit their profile and interests. Also, during this time, some interviews may be required before making an offer and a final decision can be made.

^{*} Important: Receiving admission to Tecnológico de Monterrey is different than being admitted as a candidate for an internship. You may receive admission to Tec de Monterrey as an exchange students; however, to be accepted for the internship program you will receive a separate confirmation once the evaluation process is finished.
